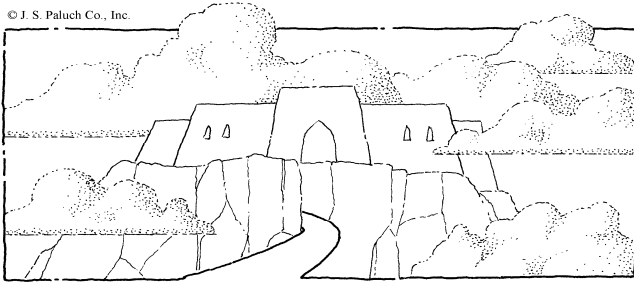

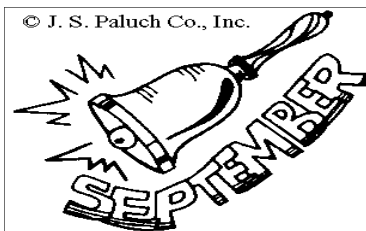
**Register for CFF after Mass**

Registration is currently taking place for CFF, Catholic Faith Formation. These classes are important for non-Catholic school children who need to be catechized in the faith. Parents need to make this a priority for their children as it is a promise you made at the time of their baptism. You may register after Masses next week or on line. Check the bulletin and website for more information to follow.

**If you have children in grades K through 8, be sure to plan on their attending CFF classes every Monday evening.** This is more than just one more activity. It is an investment in faith required of all Catholic families.

Preparation for both First Communion and for Confirmation is a two year process. For First Eucharist the preparatory period begins in the first grade; for confirmation preparatory sessions begin in the sixth grade.
